

Quick Stats on EducationSuperHighway

- EducationSuperHighway helped catalyze President Obama's **ConnectED** initiative in 2013.
- The non-profit raised **\$1 MILLION** in seed round of funding and **\$9.2 MILLION** in series A funding from investors including The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and the Chan Zuckerberg Initiative. The organization since secured an additional **\$20 MILLION** from the Chan Zuckerberg Initiative.
- In 2014, EducationSuperHighway helped increase federal E-rate funding by **1.5 billion** per year (to a total of **\$4.06 BILLION**).
- Conducted an in-depth analysis of public E-rate data and released the annual **State of the States report** on the status of broadband connectivity in America's K-12 public schools.
- Secured commitments from **50 U.S. governors** to prioritize broadband connectivity for schools in their states.
- Founder and CEO Evan Marwell was named **2015 Visionary of the Year** by *The San Francisco Chronicle*.
